One of the drives of the day was Harley Gill, competing in his first year, took 2nd junior and 5th outright

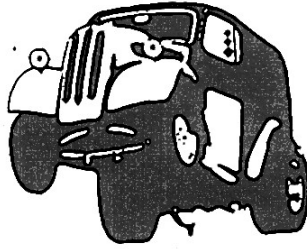
