Motorsport Australia has an aim to protect race tracks as too many are being rezoned for development or houses move closer thereby making noise levels from the racing an issue. There is an area near Avalon Airport that would be a perfect for a new track. MA managed to get some initial funding from the Government to fund a design phase and from there a team has been organised to put together an investment case that can be submitted to the State Government

There will be a wide range of manufacturers competing and some will have more cars entered so to make sure the championship is fair there will be a points system in place.
