On to this coming Saturday for the Twilight Khanacross, after trialling a couple of "different" tracks we will continue on with this theme on the day, given we have had no rain, the track held up well (Chris's words, not mine) the guys have the best they can for Saturday and the main track has a couple of out of bound areas. Yes it WILL BE dry and dusty in places and it WILL BE slippery in places, but it is the same for everyone and we will do our best to give you the best tracks possible on the day.

In the News: -

Motorsport Australia is putting part of the focus on supporting state and club level competitions. They are working projects to help and it's already been a busy start to this year with the Rolex Australian Grand Prix, 2 rounds of Shannons Speed Series, Hi-Tec Oils Bathurst 6 hour, Bosche Motorsport Australia Rally Championship round.

Australian Motorsport Hall of Fame. A ceremony was held on the Tech Stage at the recent Formula 1 Grand Prix to induct 5 new members. They are Carrie Cooper, Craig Dack, Bill Barrows OAM, Graham Withers and Jack Ahearn. These 5 were selected by a panel comprising of Motorsport Australia, Motorcycling Australia, Karting Australia, Speedway Australia and the Australian National Drag Racing Assoc.

Adelaide Motorsport Festival: Victoria Park hosted another successful event with thousands of spectators attending. Held in the heart of the city of Adelaide over 2 days, it is fast becoming a popular precursor to the Australia Grand Prix. Over 200 cars to part in 18 different categories. Not only was there action on the track, the event also held Meet and Greet, Q & A sessions and music

Scuderia Ferrari Driver Academy Asia Pacific and Oceania Selection Program. Motorsport Australia is a partner to Scuderia Ferrari's selection process. This impressive event will be run in September at the Sepang International Raceway in Malaysia. This event is used to find new talent. And those selected will be invited to the FDA Scouting World Finals in Italy. Anyone interested in participating can view an online webinar. This will include details about how to apply and what to expect at the camp.

BFGoodrich is joining the Motorsport Australia Off Road Championship and has the official naming rights. This is a real boost for the championship. BFGoodrich has been involved with off road racing for many years and their tyres have been used by many of the biggest stars.

Self-extraction webinar replay. A replay of this webinar is now available to view online. This webinar is aimed at helping officials understand the testing procedures behind the new Self-Extraction requirements. These requirements were implemented at the start of the year. There are a range of topics covered in the Webinar. This year competitors will be required to self-extract in 15 seconds but by July 2025 the requirement will be 10 seconds.
