With our days becoming more popular many of our officials are now wishing to compete. So over the couple of months you may be asked to start the process of accreditation so we can continue with the success of our club days

Notice to all competitors

Over the last couple of months it has been noted by some scrutineers that not all competitors are adhering to the requirements for fire extinguishers in their vehicles. Items to keep in mind are:

- Recommended that a metallic extinguisher bracket be used.
- Fire Extinguishers are to be tested or replaced after 3 years from Date of Manufacture, which is stamped on the cylinder, not the Date of Purchase.
- A yellow tag does not necessarily mean that the extinguisher has been tested at the correct level. The most reliable method of identification is a fire equipment services label or neck tag.

COMPLEX MAINTENANCE

There is to be a working bee at Bagshot on the 20th November starting about 10am. The main reason for this day is to Erect Frankie's Picnic area shelter beside the catering shed. It hoped that other items such as more dam and general fencing, servicing of club vehicles, general tidy up of structures including, touching and painting of the Max Jackman Timing Tower, clean up and roof repair of the machinery shed and general tidying up of the complex ready for a fresh start in 2006.

The new grader is still a little way of being serviceable due to sourcing of price comparable engine parts. Once this is rectified the time spent in the driver's seat of the grader will be greatly reduced due to the considerably larger capacity over the old unit.


CAR CLUB MERCHANDISE
