Presidents Report.

The committee has been working on the 2010 BCC calendar and it was tabled at the September General meeting and on display at the September BCC championship round. The calendar will once again be available at the October General Meeting for comment before the committee makes it final.

We have also had talks with the VCAS group; this has lead to the BCC securing 2 rounds of the VCAS at Bagshot next year. One being the November Hill Climb. The other one, a change of format for the earlier round, in the form of a Saturday day/night round in May. This has meant that we have been able to cut the BCC championship from 11 rounds to 10.

The Bendigo Car Club has a growing reputation of running good events but over recent times we have lacked support with officials on the day of the events. Once again I would like to ask everybody to offer a hand at events and take the load of the few that have been doing the work. Next year we will be trialing another system of "roistering" of members in official roles.

On Saturday the 7th November the Bendigo Car Club will behaving a social evening at the All Seasons complex, at this function there will be special guests speaking of their experiences, see attached flyer for details and be quick as seats will go fast.

November will also see the running of a hill climb at Bagshot, this is also a round of the VCAS, Supp Regs are now available. There will be 50 places reserved for BCC members if they get their entries in by the close of early entries on the Wednesday before, this means completed forms and money paid to event secretary.
