REPORTS Bagshot Hill Climb November 8th

The biggest field to attend a Bagshot event in recent memory took on the first Bagshot Hill Climb. In all 96 drivers had a go at the one kilometre event that started on the off road track near the motorkhana area then on to the back straight of the normal autocross track then following the autocross track in a clockwise manner until half way between the top of the essess and the top corner. Given the high number of entries and the dry conditions concern was that the track would break up an become very rough, this was not the case and at the end of the day black marks were aplenty as well as many of the drivers setting their fastest time on their fifth run. The event was round 10 of the Bendigo Car Club championship as well as round 10 of the VCAS, as a result all the big guns from the VCAS were there, but they didn't have it their own way. The top 7 places were all taken out by Subaru WRX's. James Stanford and Jade Lawson took the top honours but Jimmy Gill flew the flag for the BCC leading early in the day and eventually finishing 3rd over all. Harley Gill was the second BCC member and top junior in 5th outright which is a top result given the quality of the field on the day.

In all the BCC members took 5 of the 9 class wins on offer which shows that our members do have what it takes to match it with some of the best drivers in the state.
