If you have a car that was on the scheme and is no longer please let me know, as the permit is not transferable if the vehicle is sold.

Permit renewal forms are printed with 45 or 90 days. If you wish to change the number of days a new form will need to be completed

## **Event Reports**

## BCC Club Championship Rd 9 and VCAS Round 10

The November club event was also a round of the VCAS and due to the poor state of the first corner of the Hill Climb track the event was reverted back to the usual autocross with the normal start, with the finish on the back straight. 56 competitors were given the opportunity to do 6 runs with their best 3 times to count. The battle of the day was between Brendan Paynting in his WRX and Barry Nowell in a Ford Laser Special, the pair swapped times all day with Brendan coming out on top by 0.6sec. John Hardiman was the second BCC member in 6<sup>th</sup> O/R with Brad Hall 7<sup>th</sup> O/R also in WRX's.

In the other class's on the day Mick Elvey 4<sup>th</sup> in class C with Dean Smith in 6<sup>th</sup>. Josh Watson was the best BCC in class D in 5<sup>th</sup>, Doug Adams was the best in class E in 9<sup>th</sup> after swapping BMW's midway through the day. Jessica Farrar was the best of our juniors in 5<sup>th</sup> in class and 46<sup>th</sup> O/R. Melissa Debnam was the highest placed BCC lady in 33<sup>rd</sup> O/R.

## SANTA'S PRE CHRISTMAS WARMUP ENDURO Round 6 Off Road Mallee Shield

4 crews from the Bendigo Car Club were among the 11 crews to take on the Bagshot track for the final off road event of the year. Rain in the lead up kept the dust down until later in the day.

All four of the BCC members finished in eth top 5 in prologue with Ken and Jeremy Holt (258) first ahead of Ian Edelsten (SLORC) (191), with Matt and Jim Coombs (213) in third. Craig Button/David Anderson (469) in 4<sup>th</sup> and Paul Volta/Frank Bell (288) in in 5<sup>th</sup>. The teams then went out for their first 1 hour leg in an anti-clock wise direction with the top 5 drivers all completing 14 laps, the only change was Matt and Jim were now in 2<sup>nd</sup> overall.

The course direction was then changed to clockwise, Paul Volta didn't make the restart due to suspension and engine mount breakages, and on lap 2 Ian Edelsten broke a CV joint meaning that the 3 remaining BCC members lead the field. This is the way it continued until the 14<sup>th</sup> and last lap when Matt and Jim stopped with a loose coil wire losing at least 2 minutes meaning they dropped to 3<sup>rd</sup> outright.

In the end Ken and Jeremy won with 28 laps in total, Craig and David also 28 laps but 3 minutes behind with Matt and Jim 2 minutes further back also on 28 laps, giving the BCC a clean sweep of the event.
