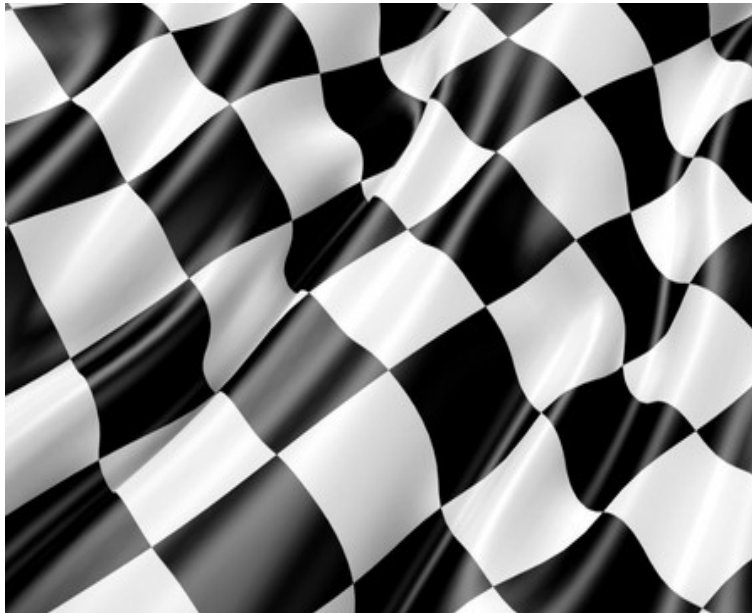

Time to take a different approach now as we spend our time in a different way, the plans are to take to the road in our VW Beetle we've just restored. So give us a wave as you pass by,

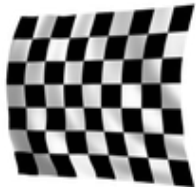

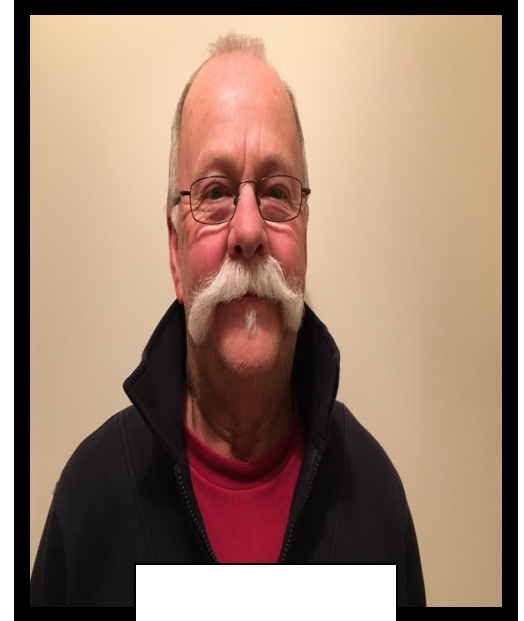

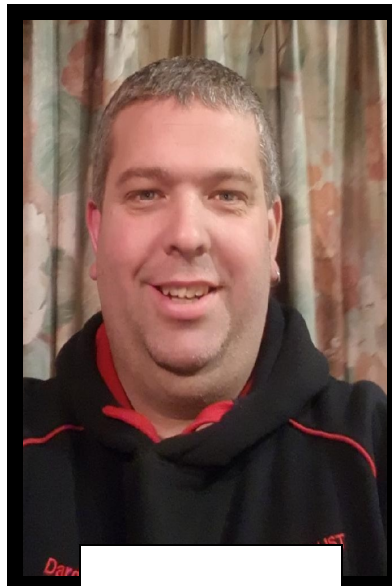
