Coming up we have the Easter Salesyard Dash, on Easter Saturday as usual and again this year it is a Khanacross on the back section of the complex. Keep an eye out for the Supp Regs.

With all this positive stuff happening in the club, I do have a little gripe, that is there is so few members actually helping out with our large events with only a handful getting involved, to continue with the great reputation our club has running these events we need you help, even if it is only for a couple of hours in the day, any help is help. So please keep this in mind when we run our events in the future.

- National Speed & Auto Tests:
The dates for the 2022 have been confirmed: 10 -11 Sept, 1-2 Oct, 16 Oct, 20-23 Oct. The first event will be the Motorsport Australia Khanacross Championship and will be hosted by the Southern District Car Club SA. Supercheap Auto's Club Development Fund. The development fund is open for 2022 applications and will provide a funding allocation framework to car clubs. Round 1 funding closes on 31 May 2022.
- Audika partnership with Motorsport Australia:
Launched during Hearing Awareness Week, the partnership aims to provide members with information on the importance of hearing care.
