In saying that at the last committee meeting a return to track option was discussed and sent to Motorsport Australia. There will have to be some changes made to the way we do things, which we all have to help out with ensure we can play on and off the track.

At this stage with gathering sizes, general meetings at the clubrooms are a no go, using the 4 sq metre requirement we can have 38 people in the Maiden Gully room but we are limited to 10.

Bagshot however is a little different, allowing cluster sizes of 20 people, of which we can have 3 or 4 clusters around the complex. So, the committee are working to get something going in July, regulations allowing.

Supplementary Regulations for an event on the 19th July are currently with Motorsport Australia for approval.

If this is possible, we have several opportunities in for the rest of the year to run events.

I know there are a lot of enquiries regarding the Mt Tarrengower Hill Climb, at this stage Chris and the hill climb committee are watching government requirements with fingers crossed, the committee have indicated that an announcement will be made in early August on which way they choose to go.

Once we are given approval to get back on track, we will let you all know asap.


