Presidents Report

Where has the year gone, the club membership year is fast approaching, end of June. Renewal forms will be emailed out and on the club website asap. Once again, the club is offering a \$10 discount if your membership is paid before the 31st July.

With that we are also heading towards our AGM in August, we currently still have a vacancy and there are 3 sitting committee members that are up for renewal, please consider nominating for the committee to help guide the club into the future. This is also a reminder for the members who have vehicles on the Vicroads Club Permit Scheme, that if your membership is not current you cannot legally drive your toy on the road and we as a club are required to notify Vicroads if you are no longer members.

On the subject of Vicroads CPS, now that things are getting back to normal as far as COVID is concerned members who have vehicles on the scheme ARE required to attend 2 general meetings and participate in 2 other activities organised by the club during the year. There are a few exceptions to this depending on the circumstances.

Over the last few months, we have undertaken a few projects, well at least started them, both at Bagshot and Maiden Gully. As posted on the Facebook page last week we had a 2-day working bee to replace the boundary fence against the piggery, the piggery had supplied the materials for us to complete this, there is a little more left to do, north of the of firebreak gate, we will schedule a day later in the year to tackle that. We have also begun planning for the new canteen, it is hoped that we will have some action soon, keep an eye and ear out for a working bee to stand this up. The club toilets are a headache for Chris trying to get contractors to come and quote on this, he has been able to get a couple, just waiting to see which one comes out best for us.

Over the next 2 months we have 3 separate Victorian State Championship events at Bagshot and the Huntly Salesyard, the first is the Off-Road round on the 3rd July at Bagshot, at the time of writing this report we are still waiting for conformation that we can use the piggery land. Then 2 weeks later on the 16th July we host the Victorian Motorkhana Championship at the Salesyards. Then finally on the 31st July we are back at Bagshot for the Victorian Khanacross Championship. Helpers are needed for all these events.

This coming Sunday (5th June) is our final round of the 2021/2022 BCC club Championship at Bagshot. Supp Regs should be on the same email as this newsletter was sent out on, again it should be on the club website as well. This weekend a couple of our normal key officiating members will be away, so I will be calling on every one to help in some way.
