Wakefield Park Raceway in NSW is fighting for its survival. It's one of only 2 major motorsport tracks in NSW yet the state has the most motorsport participants. The NSW Land and Environment Court ruled that the track would be limited to operate for only 30 days per year putting it in danger of making it financially unviable to keep open. So until a solution is found, the track is now closed.
